

Pocket Super Scarf

Skill Level: Easy

Materials:

Approx. 300 yards of Bernat Softee Chunky in Grey Heather (28046)

- Yarn Info: 100g/108 yards per skein
- Substitute with any super bulky weight yarn.

Crochet Hook: 8.0mm [US-L]

Gauge: 4" = 8 STS

Finished Measurements: pictured is approx. 62" long. Watch video to see how to customize size.

Scarf Instructions

Row 1: FSC 160 STS.

Row 2: Turn, CH 1, SC in BLO in each ST across. 160 STS

Row 3: Repeat **Row 2**. 160 STS

Row 4: Turn, tall CH, DC in each ST across. 160 STS

Row 5: Turn, CH 1, SC in each ST across. 160 STS

Rows 6-7: Turn, CH 1, SC in BLO in each ST across. 160 STS

Row 8: Turn, tall CH, DC in each ST across.
160 STS

Rows 9-12: Repeat **Rows 5-8**. 160 STS

Rows 13-15: Repeat **Rows 5-7**. 160 STS

Fasten off and move on to pocket instructions.

Pocket Instructions (see video for help)

Each side will be worked the same.

1st Side: Flip up as much of the scarf as you want for the pocket with the right sides facing in. Beginning in corner of scarf, SC join the 1st side, do not fasten off.

Next, with yarn attached, SC 2 times in just the edge of the scarf (top of pocket) to make turn, then SC evenly across end of scarf to create a nice edge to the pocket. SC 2 times in last ST of edge to make next turn. SC join down the other side of the scarf. Fasten off.

2nd Side: Repeat same steps as 1st side.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Abbreviations Used:

BLO: back loop only

CH: chain

DC: double crochet

SC: single crochet

SL ST: slip stitch

ST(S): stitch(es)

YO: yarn over
