

YANA Cancer Comfort Beanie

Skill Level: Easy

Materials:

Medium Worsted weight yarn in your choice of three colors:

- Red **CA**
- Light Grey **CB**
- Dark Grey

Crochet Hook: 5mm [US-H]

Finished Measurements: approx. 22" circumference (fits most adults)

Gauge: 2"= 6 DCs and 5 rows

Abbreviations Used:

- **CH:** chain
- **DC:** double crochet
- **SC:** single crochet
- **SL ST:** slip stitch
- **ST(S):** stitch(es)
- ***...*-** pattern repeat, work the stitches contained within the asterisks across the body of the project when called for. The pattern will tell you when to stop the repeat.

Special Note:

- CH 3 counts as a DC throughout.
- The color changes are just suggestions. You can make a solid color beanie or create your own color change by choosing different RNDs to change color on.

Beanie Instructions

With **CA**, CH 4, SL ST in 1st CH to form ring

RND 1: CH 3, DC 9 times in ring. Join RND with SL ST in top of CH 3. 10 STS

RND 2: CH 3, DC in same ST, DC 2 times in each ST around. Join RND with SL ST in top of CH 3. 20 STS

RND 3: Repeat **RND 2**. 40 STS

RND 4: CH 3, DC in same ST, *DC in next 2 STS, DC 2 times in next ST*, repeat between *. Join RND with SL ST in top of CH 3. 54 STS

RND 5: CH 3, *DC 2 times in next ST, DC in next 3 STS*, repeat between * to last ST, DC 2 times in last ST. Join RND with SL ST in top of CH 3. 68 STS

RND 6: CH 3, DC each ST around. Join RND with SL ST in top of CH 3. 68 STS

RNDs 7-11: Repeat **RND 6**. 68 STS

At the end of **RND 11**, join **CB**, and fasten off **CA**.

RNDs 12-13: Repeat **RND 6**. 68 STS

At the end of **RND 13**, join **CC** and fasten off **CB**.

RNDs 14-15: Repeat **RND 6**. 68 STS

RND 16: CH 1, SC in each ST around. Join RND with SL ST in 1st SC. 68 STS

Fasten off and weave in ends.
